Charleston Artist Guild in Charleston, SC, Offers Works by Jane Ann Sweeny

The Charleston Artist Guild in Charleston, SC, will present *A Collaboration of Wood Grain and Art in Woodcuts*, an exhibition featuring a collection of limited edition self-pulled woodcut prints by Jane Ann Sweeny, on view in the Guild Gallery, from Oct. 1 - 31, 2020.

Sweeny received her BFA in Printmaking from Clemson University. She is a visual artist, spending five years in Los Angeles to focus on different aspects of her craft. Her work is heavily influenced by music and by the Charleston environment. Her work is in the art collections of The Indigo Girls, Brandi Carlile, Ani DiFranco and Brian "Head" Welch. You can find her art primarily in collections in Los Angeles, CA, and Charleston, SC.

Sweeny is a woodcut artist, a rare thing to find these days. She meticulously carves and gouges away at wood panels, sometimes having to alter her original plan according to the knots in the wood. Once she is finished carving, the woodblock is

covered with ink and the image on the wood left from carving is then transferred to paper using a printing press. The woodblock is run through an old-school press once for every color she uses, therefore the color left on the wood panel is the last color she transferred.

Sweeny makes a limited edition of original, self-pulled prints.
