20th Annual Bluffton Arts & Seafood Festival Takes Place in Bluffton, SC - Oct. 1 - 20, 2024

The Bluffton Arts & Seafood Festival is back for the twentieth year – and still growing in Bluffton, SC. What started as a one-day event in 2005 and quickly became a week of festivities, is slated for 20 days of activities this year in historic Bluffton showcasing the arts, history, culture and locally harvested seafood as we celebrate 20 years of tradition in 20 days. Festival events are scheduled Oct. 1 through Oct. 20, 2024.

Along with the traditional Blessing of the Fleet and Boat Parade on the May River on Sunday, Oct. 13, at 4pm, the local art scene will again be highlighted. Our Sunday activities include a Showcase of Local Art, at the galleries and an outdoor art exhibit in Martin Park from 11am-4pm in the heart of Old Town Bluffton, as well as the first Oyster Roast of the season at Bluffton Oyster Park at 5pm
