HOW TO BUILD A BOAT

How to Build a Boat, presented by The CEW Collaborative, explores the significance of boat building through observations and classical drawing techniques. Our five high school students observed college students building wooden boats and, from their observations, began learning how to document the boat-building process. Collaborative Fellows used foundational drawing techniques to create their sketches, studies, and final drawings. The Collaborative Founder and artist, Charles Edward Williams, in tandem with Walter Atkins (Wooden Boat Building program director, Cape Fear Community College) shared the experience of two historical and traditional methods: boat building and drawing. These methods are tied to the important lens that has shaped the rich landscape of our coastal communities. These works by the CEW Collaborative Fellows are the essence of our exhibit, titled How to Build a Boat.
