Brookgreen Gardens in Pawleys Island, SC, will present the *Enchanted Storybook Forest*, an exhibition of storybook playhouses created by local builders, architects and organizations, on view from May 19 through Oct. 31, 2013.

"Each house is based on a classic children's story or nursery rhyme and will encourage reading and interaction with the natural world," said Bob Jewell, President and CEO at Brookgreen. "Our goal is to inspire children's imaginations and give families another reason to visit the gardens." Special programs and activities will occur throughout the season and include storytelling under the trees, arts and crafts and lessons on nature. The exhibit will be open daily and will be free with garden admission.
