Carolina Gallery in Spartanburg, NC, will present *Beneath the Surface*, featuring recent work by Western North Carolina artist Keith Spencer, on view from May 8 through June 20, 2015.

The sheer volume of commentary reviewing Keith Spencer's "explosive color" and "confident brushwork" are testaments to a style that is at once powerfully sensual and keenly contemplative.

Spencer earned Bachelor Degrees in both Biology and Art, an education that allowed the biologist and the artist in him to overcome their adversarial nature to more fully express the mystery of life than either could have achieved alone.

Early in his career, Spencer's style was much tighter. As his style evolved, his brand of realism became more painterly, more expressionistic, and eventually flirted with abstraction. But even at its most abstract, there has always been a sense of connection with what is real.

Under the persona of Keith Spencer Studio, Spencer has created illustration, fine art and design that can be found around the world in advertisements, books, package designs, posters, catalogs, web designs, logos, promotions and surface prints and embroideries for active, team, leisure and licensed apparel.
