Fabulous Fakes: Master Artwork Parodies from Art League will be on view at the Art League of Hilton Head Gallery on Hilton Head Island, SC, from June 28 - July 21, 2022. A reception will be held July 1, from 5-7pm. Impress your friends with an original Picasso (or the next best thing).

For only four days, Art League of Hilton Head will host a much-loved and anticipated alternate artistic reality—one in which Monet's famous water lilies host amphibian residents, a Van Gogh countryside features a very modern putting green, and Whistler's Mother enjoys a cocktail.

Fabulous Fakes is a four-day exhibit that takes inspiration from the old masters. Some artworks are replicas of famous paintings with an often humorous or whimsical twist; others are inspired by the techniques of the masters but have an entirely different subject matter, medium, or color palette. "This exhibit is a chance to have some fun," says Kristen McIntosh, General Manager. "Artists don't always have to take their work so seriously, although it is a challenge to duplicate the works of some of the masters. The skill required to create some of these replicas is astonishing."
