## Art & Light Gallery in Greenville, SC, Offers Works by Adam DuShole

Art & Light Gallery in Greenville, SC, will present *The Longest Day Ever*, a solo exhibition of work by Greenville, SC, artist Adam DuShole, on view at the Art & Light Annex, from July 14 through Aug. 26, 2023. A reception will be held on July 14, from 6-8pm.

Adam DuShole constructs large scale wood-cut sculptures in a bright palette of primaries that recall the visual language of traditional folk art. He thinks of the work as an inventory of artifacts that represent a collective history, one that he navigates with uncertainty about the future while reconciling a tenuous relationship with history. The familiarity of shape and color in DuShole's work can, at first glance, be taken in as simple tchotchke. But as a deeper connection to mythology, folklore, and superstition emerges, the work becomes a candid examination of the rituals and practices that define cultural identity and tradition.

DuShole, whose work is influenced as much by current trends in street art and animation as it is by the history of anthropology and folk art states, "The work included in *The Longest Day* exhibition provides a new context for ideas that have often been relegated to peripheral spaces or overlooked as simple tchotchke. With shape and form that fluctuates between painting and sculpture, I examine mythology as a manifestation of humanity's ability to anthropomorphize even the smallest facets of the natural world."

Atlanta-based artist Dilling explores inner and outer landscapes through her abstract paintings, and they are a celebration of the senses. The show can be seen online and in person at the restaurant. Dilling's art makes reference to nature around her but also an emotional territory within.

The duality of interior/external realms gives the work a depth of meaning. She uses gestural marks, printmaking techniques, and layered colors to express a mood or memory. Dilling is influenced by the energy of Abstract Expressionism and the softness of Impressionism, and she combines them in her own unique way. "My desire is to create a calming visual space" says Dilling, "but I also want elements of surprise and contrast, so that viewing a painting is an experience of discovery."

Dilling received a BA from Indiana University and a BFA from Georgia State University. As the child of a German mother and an American father, she grew up loving

culture and travel, leading her to attend art programs in England, South Africa, Spain and Italy. With an interest in science, she was awarded project grants to work with scientists from the Center for Chemical Evolution and create related exhibitions. All of these experiences continue to influence her art.

Dilling has received numerous grants and awards, and has been featured in several professional publications, including Studio Visit Magazine and New American Paintings. She has exhibited both nationally and internationally, and her work is in collections around the world, including the Museum of Contemporary Art of Georgia, the City of Atlanta, Fidelity Investments, UPS, Four Seasons Hotel Marrakech, Morocco and Conrad Hilton Hong Kong.

Dilling helped found the Atlanta Printmakers Studio and served on the board for many years. She has devoted time to nonprofits such as the Hambidge Center for the Arts and Burnaway, and organizes residencies for professional artists. She also has many years of graphic design experience. Based in Atlanta, she lives with her husband Jon and her two dogs.

Since 2007, Teresa Roche and her team have offered creative, inventive and

inspiring pieces that help collectors merge affordability with discovery by showcasing one-of-a-kind elements that tell a story! Art & Light Gallery features over 40 emerging to established local, regional, and international artists in the gallery and online. With a hand-picked collection of artists, they have just the right piece for those casually buying gift-able art, those just wading into collecting, the designers hunting the perfect piece for clients and the seasoned art collector.
