It envelops Charleston's trademark as the Holy City while honoring the nine members of Emanuel A.M.E Church whose lives ended too soon. Each of the nine Charleston Palmetto Roses are hand-woven using leaves from local Palmetto Trees.

It is ingrained with a history that dates back to the Civil War. Tradition holds that Southern ladies would give their true love a Palmetto Rose to keep them safe during battle.
