The Art League of Hilton Head on Hilton Head Island, SC, will present *3Visions 3Voices*, featuring the works of LouAnne Barrett, Steve Edelstein, and Kelly Richard, on view at the League Gallery, from Sept. 17 through Oct. 18, 2024. Each artist is offering a gallery talk: Richard on Sept. 20, 11am-12pm; Edelstein on Sept. 25, 11am-12pm; and Barrett on Sept. 27, 2:30-4pm, and Oct. 7, 10:30am-12pm.

Local artists LouAnne Barrett, Steve Edelstein, and Kelly Richard use painting, photography, and sculpture, respectively, to interpret the unique beauty of Lowcountry birds such as egrets, herons, and pelicans, as well as other local wildlife.

LouAnne Barrett, a lifelong artist, works with various media such as watercolor, acrylic, oil, pastel, and multi-media to create her works. Prior to moving to the Lowcountry, she was an Interior Designer and taught design at the local college in southern California. She taught art for 18 years in Hilton Head. Currently, she still enjoys teaching youth and adult classes at various local locations.
